RE: PROPOSED REFINEMENTS TO ATNS TARIFFS

Thank you for your letter dated 15 April 2005, the contents of which have been noted.

We, the undersigned, representing all spheres of General Aviation, note your stated deadline of the 20th April for submissions. We find this to be totally inadequate, particularly since it affords us no more than three (3) working days to comply.

At this juncture you leave us with no alternative but to urgently apply for a moratorium on the implementation of the published fees effective 1 April 2005. This would allow us to extensively research all alternatives and technical issues and to adequately propose a feasible alternative, which we believe will be acceptable to all parties.

It is anticipated that this moratorium be effective from 1 April 2005 until 31 August 2005. This period is required in order for us to complete our research and investigations, and to compile our findings in a comprehensive manner.

Should this application be unsuccessful we will have no alternative but to pursue our legal options to the maximum extent.

We respectfully request a response to this writing by close of business on Friday, 29 April 2005.

We assure you of our good intentions and that we are at all times available for further discussions.
